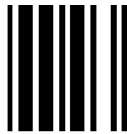

Introduction

VGM Barcode Labels, (VGMBarcodes.exe), is an easy to use barcode printing application designed to print barcode labels for Electronic Gaming Machines, (EGMs), Video Gaming Machines, (VGMs), which are all known as slot machines, and the cash cans associated with that EGM. The format is set to "3 of 9", which is also known as EAN 39, (the IGT Advantage™ default barcode type).

VGMBarcodes.exe will print a machine label, "hot" cash can label and a "cold" cash can label.

The program's main purpose was designed around the IGT Advantage Casino System which needs three bar code labels per machine in a "M1" and "C2" format. However, depending upon your specific application and system, the prefix can be easily changed. Any number can be used, again depending upon your specific application and system. A working example for the Advantage™ Casino System is by using the machine number in all three labels. Then utilizing an M1 prefix, a C23 prefix for the "Hot" cash can and "C24" for the "cold" cash can. (Advantage™ needs the Machine label prefix to be "M1" and Cash Can labels to be prefixed with "C2".

This example would be:

M1100251 Machine label for Advantage™ system
C23100251 For Hot cash can for Advantage™ system
C24100251 For Cold cash can for Advantage™ system

The actual machine number here is 100251 with proper prefixes applied.

VGMBarcodes.exe currently prints on three of the more popular sized Avery® or Avery® compatible labels. Those labels are:

5160 1" X 2 5/8"
5164 3 1/3" X 4" (Large format)
5261 1" X 4"

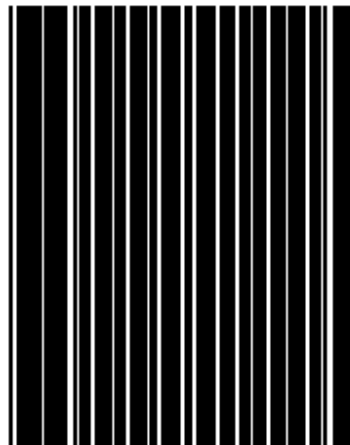

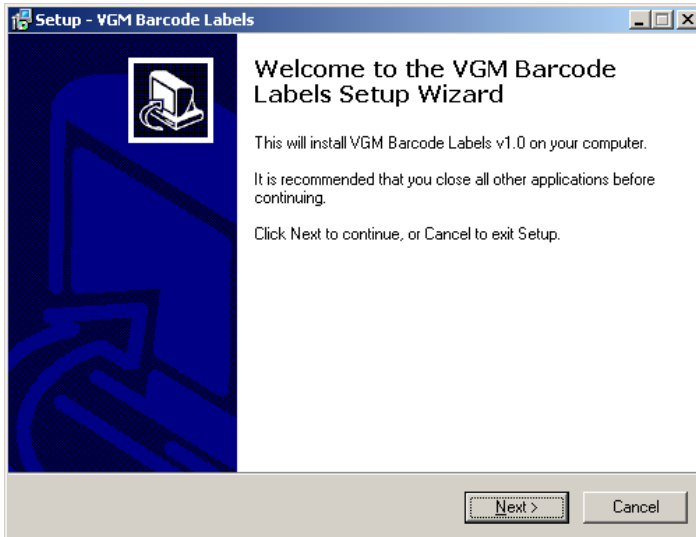

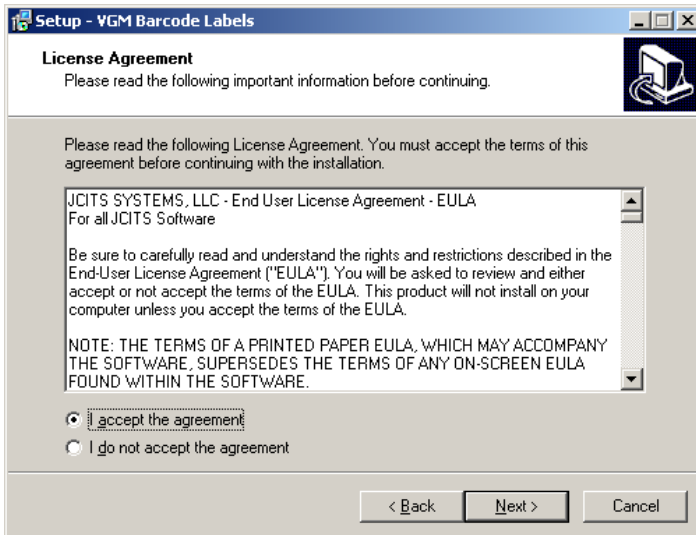


Installation

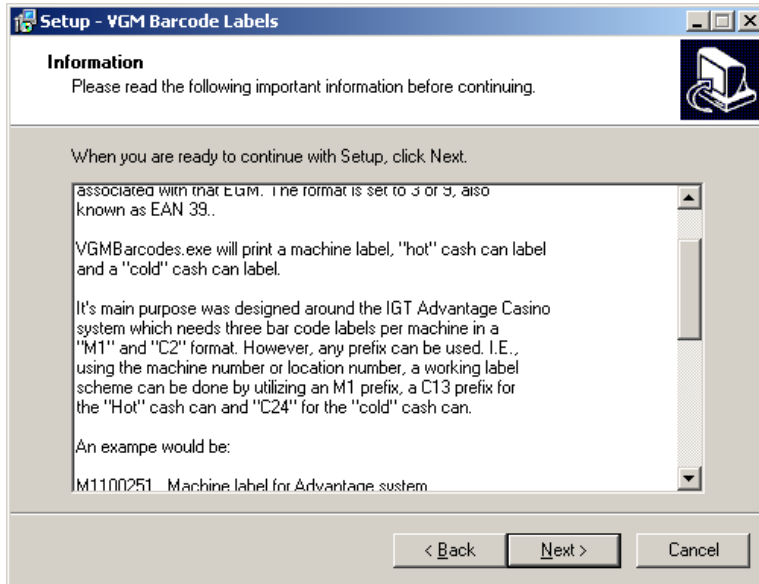
Installation is easy using the VGMBBarcodeVx.x.x.x_Setup.exe program supplied. The 'x.x.x.x' portion refers to the version being installed. Run the setup program and perform the following steps:



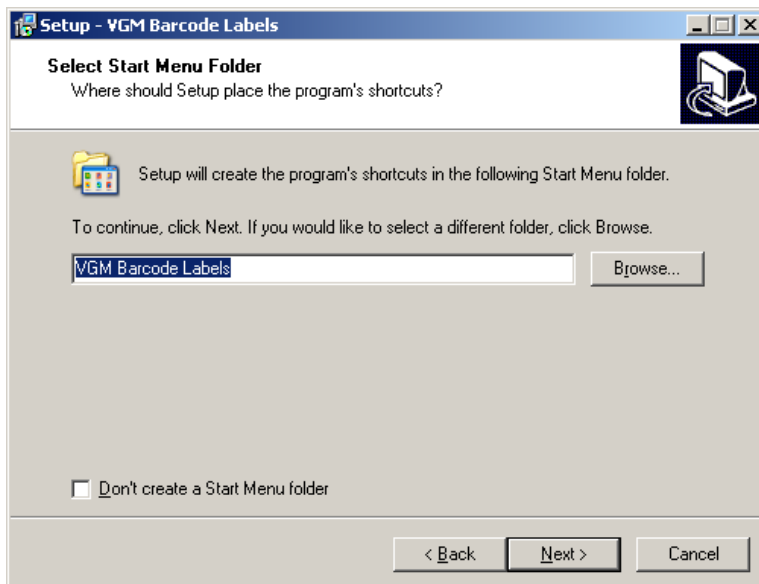
Click Next at the Welcome screen. The End User License Agreement (EULA and below) will now show. Please accept the Agreement and click 'Next'.



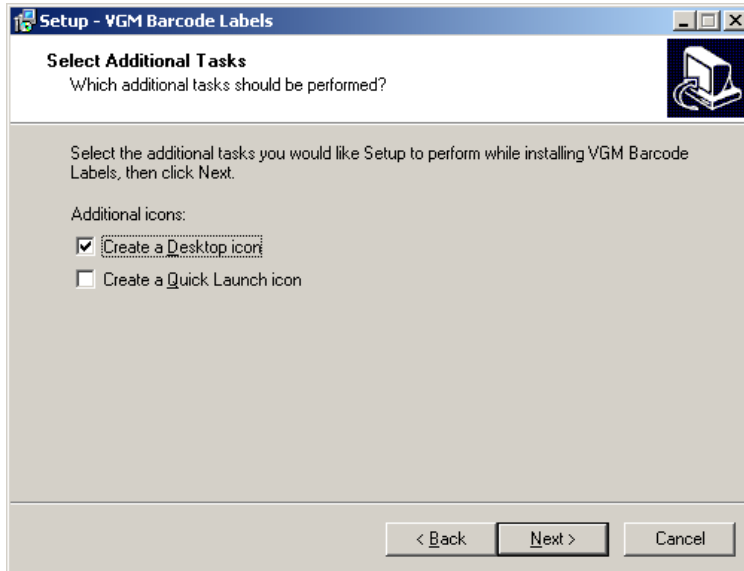
The Information Screen now appears and important information or changes may be included. When finished reading, click 'Next'.



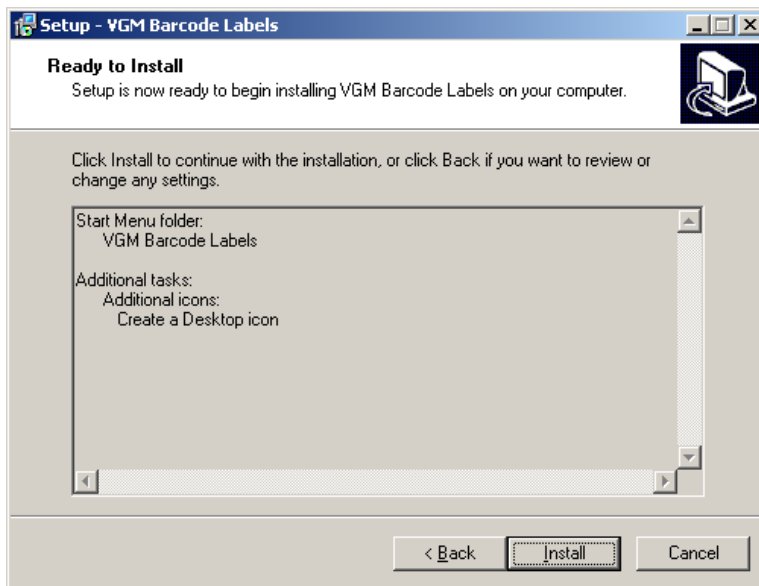
The following window will allow you change the name of the shortcut group in your Programs/Start Menu Group and further asks you if you whether or not you want a Start Menu Group created. It is suggested that you just click 'Next'.



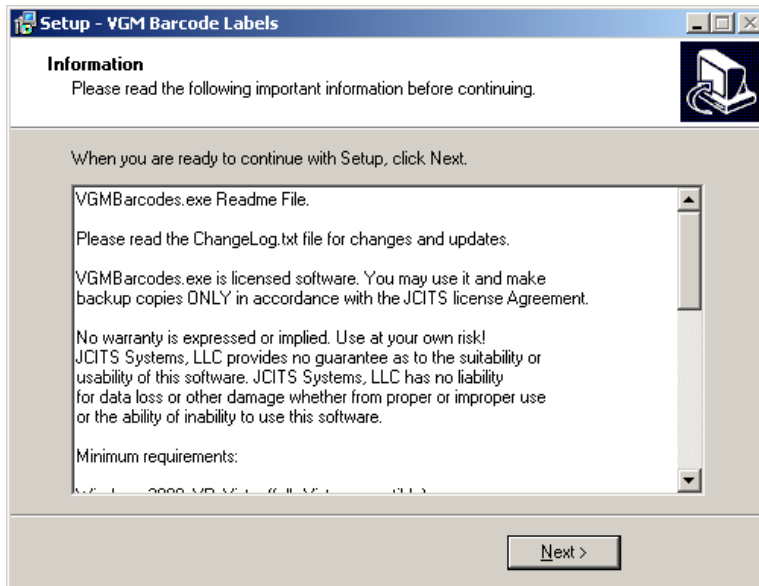
The next window in the installation asks whether you want a Desktop Icon and/or a Quick Launch icon. Check your preference and click 'Next'.



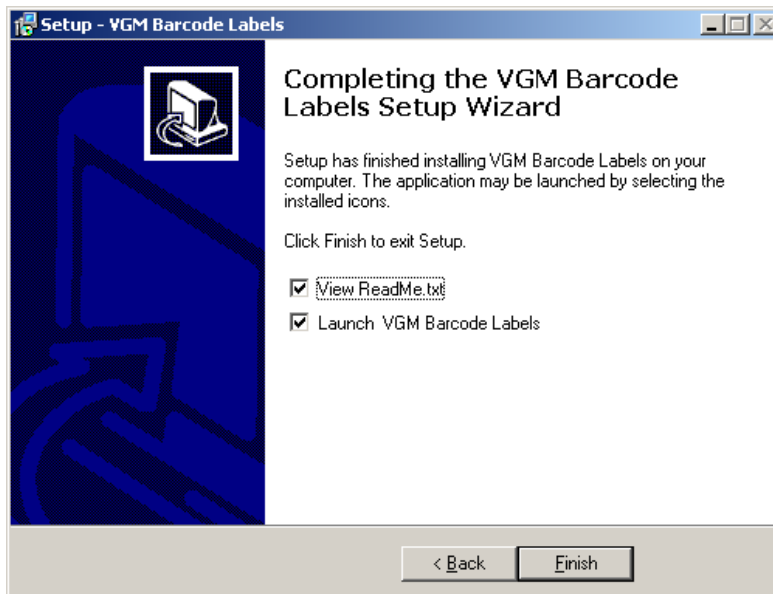
"Ready to Install" will show and when ready click 'Install'.



You will then see a progress window and when installation is complete, the Read Me file is shown (following page). Click 'Next' when you are finished reading..



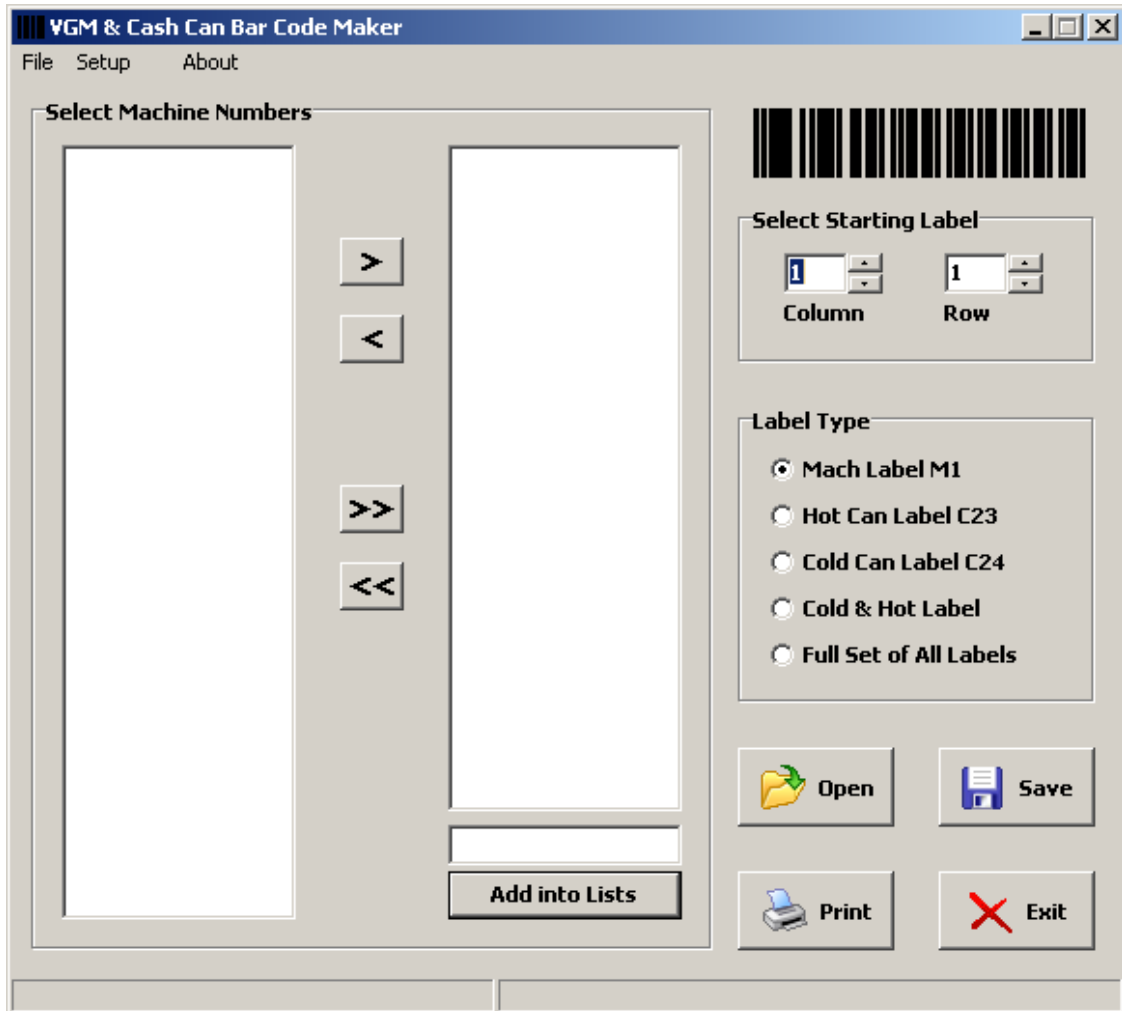
You're almost finished! Just one more window to go. This window allows you to reread the Read Me file, (which is also installed in your program folder), and launch, (run), the barcode labels application.



Click 'Finish' and you are all done!

Setup

When you first run VGMBarcodes.exe, you will see the following window:



Click Setup in the top menu bar, second item from the left.


A drop down menu will show with the following options:

5261 Label Type

Label Prefixes...

Click on 'Label Type'. To the right of this menu item the installed label types will display. Click on the type/size of label you desire and a checkmark will show. The default label is the 5160 type.

When you click on 'Label Prefixes...' the following window will show allowing you to select the prefixes you need for your installation.

Once any of this information is checked and OK clicked, the information is saved and your changes will become your defaults.

Menu Items

The top menu shows the following menu items

File

Setup (discussed previously in Setup)

About

The File menu item has the same buttons that appear in the lower right portion of the main window. This is just for convenience since some people are used to using menu bars.

File

Open: Opens the main list

Save: Saves any changes made to the main list.

Import From Database (Server)... Opens a database import Wizard.

Print: Prints labels for items in the print list box.

Exit: Closes the application

About will show the About box:

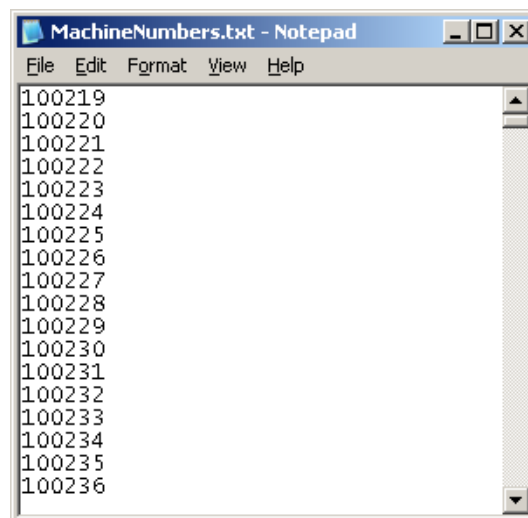

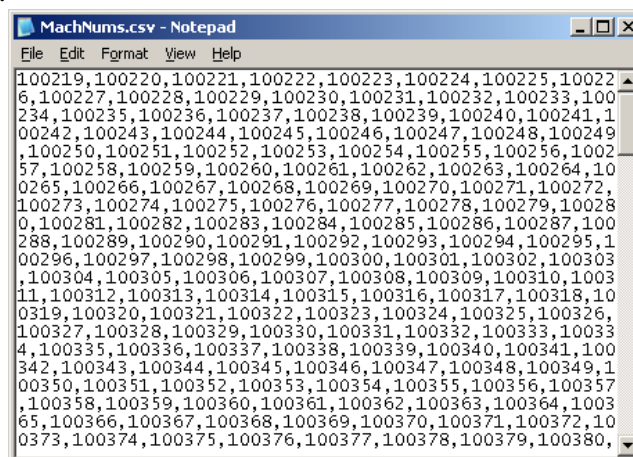
Opening Your Machine List

You must first get a text list of your machine numbers. This may be exported from your gaming system software as a comma delimited or text file.

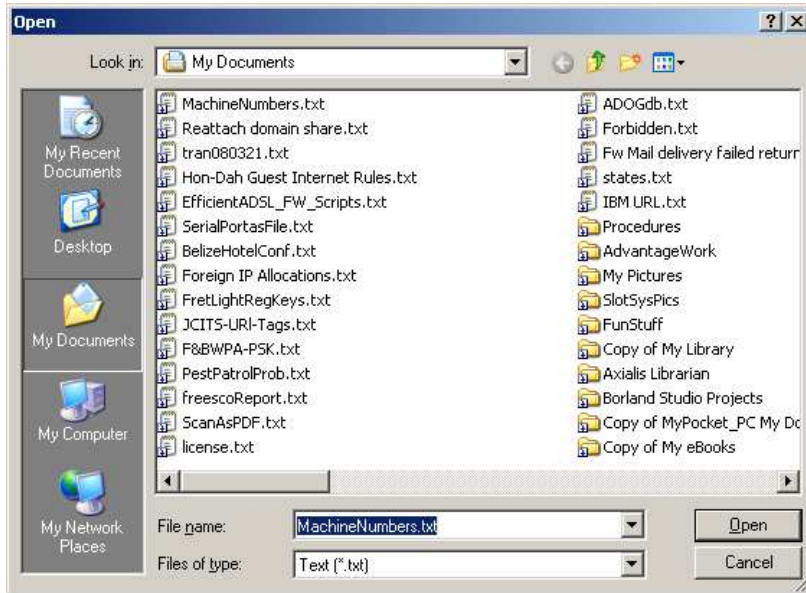
Important: To ensure ease of use, export **ONLY** the one column of machine numbers, asset numbers or machine location numbers. Exporting them as a text or as a CSV (comma delimited) file, will *usually* create a list of your numbers with a carriage return and line feed causing them to stack up vertically when viewed with notepad.exe. The best method is to export into an Excel® spreadsheet, delete all other columns and export or ‘Save As’ an MS-DOS text file.



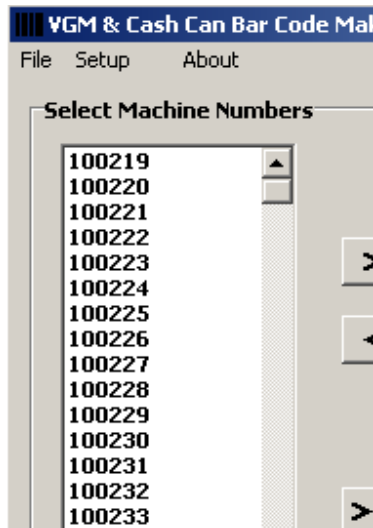
Important: Should each of your numbers be comma separated and one long string when viewed in Notepad.exe, click Files of Type and choose “Comma Delimited (*.csv)”.



Once you have your list click 'Open'. Navigate to the file's location, click on your file and click 'Open' in the Open window.

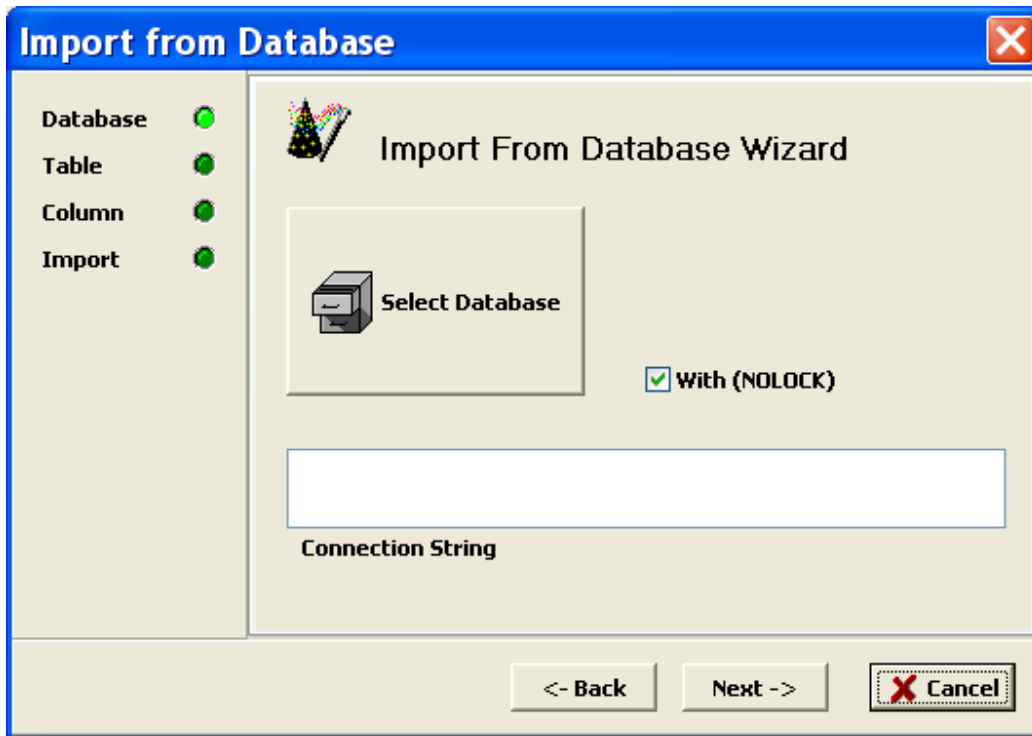


All of your machine numbers will now be visible in the left hand list box.



Importing from a Database

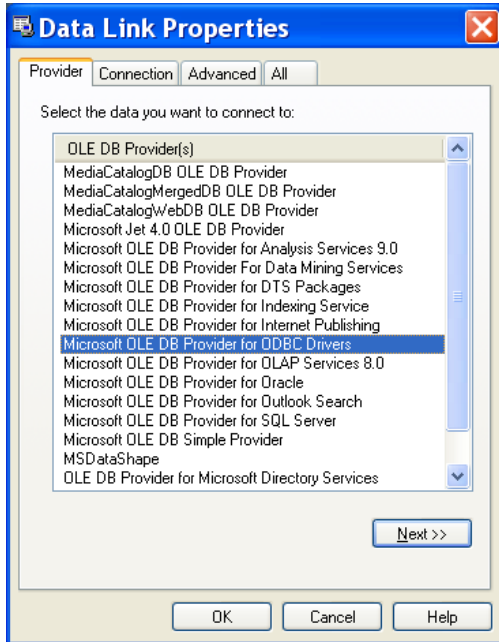
When you click the **Import From Database (Server)...** menu item a “Wizard” will show helping to guide you through the import of machine numbers (or values you choose which are stored in a database or database server), The Wizard looks like:



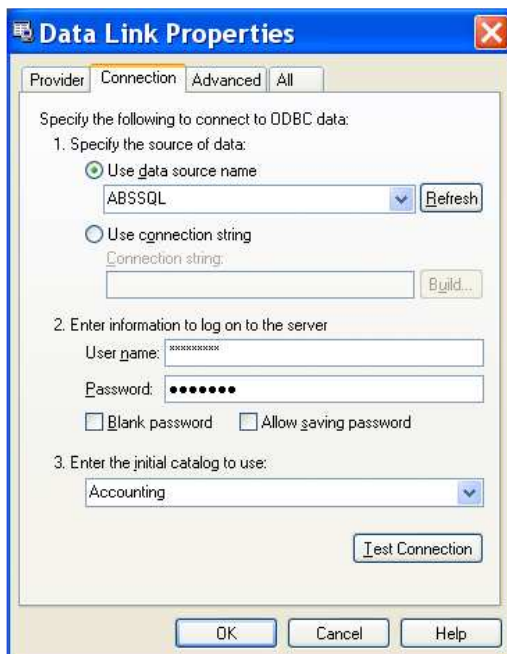
Caution: *This Wizard is used for obtaining machine data from your gaming system’s database. Important: *Any extract from the IGT Advantage Casino System should use With (NOLOCK) Checked to help ensure system integrity. The ability to uncheck this, (turn this option off), will allow the Wizard to use other database systems, such as a Microsoft Access database. (Access databases do not use NOLOCK, as may others). The Wizard will try and check for any Microsoft Jet database connection and automatically uncheck the “With (NOLOCK)” option.*

Once the wizard displays, click the “Select Database” button. A new window shows looking like:



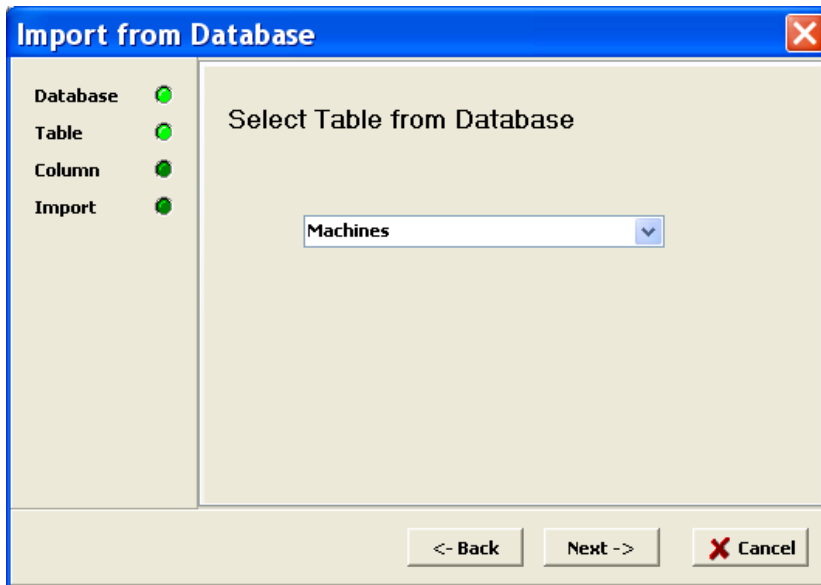
Depending upon your computer and setup, you may have more or fewer of these options. For the Advantage Casino System, Click the data provider selected above; “Microsoft OLE DB Provider for ODBC drivers”. Click “Next” and enter the correct information, user name, password and default catalog (i.e. database), that was provided to you or your I.T. staff to connect to the accounting database.



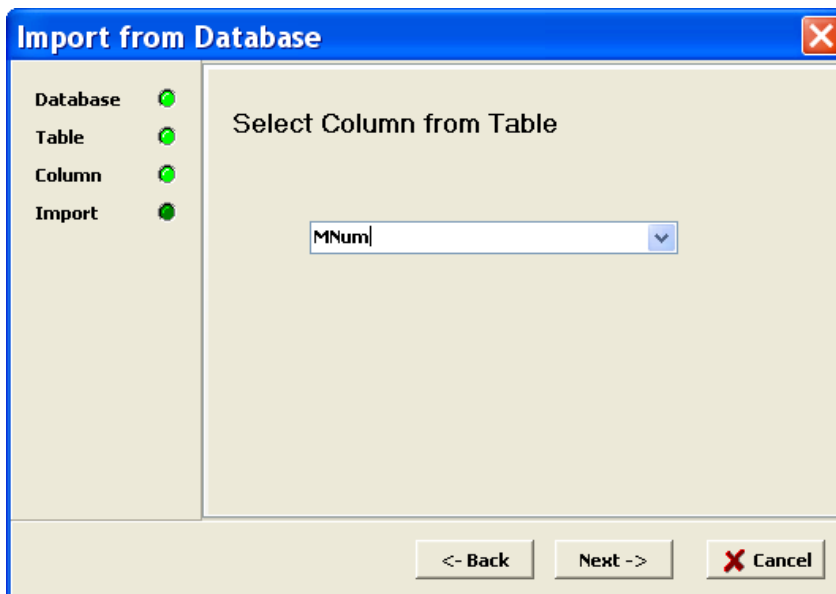
You may click “Test Connection” and/or click “OK”. You will return to the first Wizard page but with a Connection String entered into the text box. If the connection string is wrong, an error will occur.

Important: Make certain that for Advantage you check “Allow saving password”.

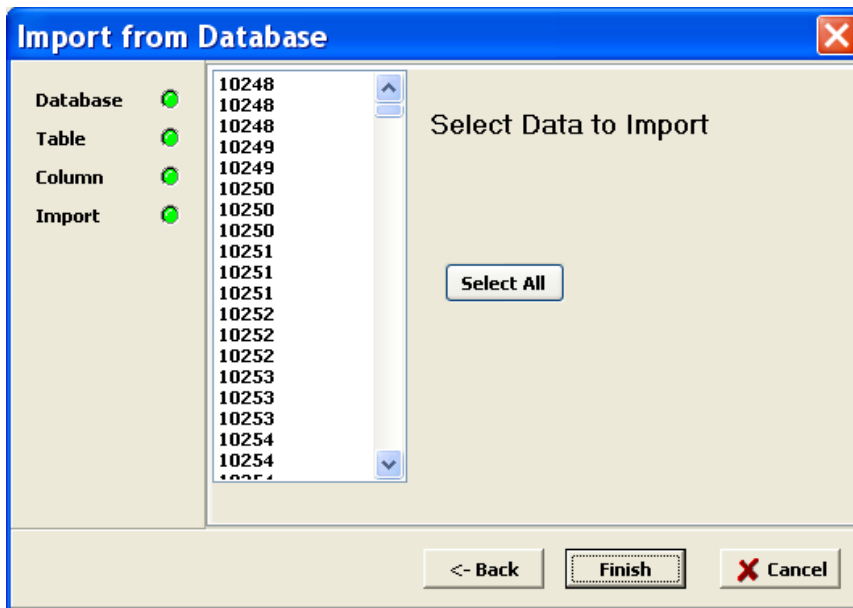
Click the “Next” button in the lower right portion of the Wizard.



For Advantage, select the ‘Machines’ table from the database. Click “Next”.



For Advantage, select the ‘MNum’ column from the Machines Table. Click “Next”.



You're at the last page of the Wizard! You must now select the items in the list you want to import into the main application list box. You can click the "Select All" button, or select any one or all of the items listed. You may do this by holding the Ctrl key, Shift key and then selecting/dragging the mouse, or selectively clicking the items you want.

When you click Finish, the Wizard closes and the selected machine data will appear in the main list box.

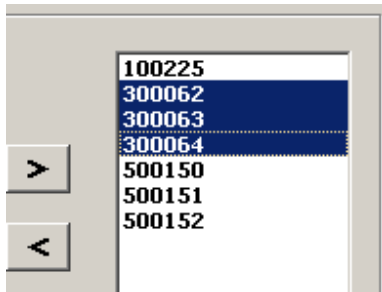
Your database connection settings are saved for your next use.

At anytime in the Wizard, you may go forward or back in order to change your settings.

Selecting Items to Print

You may click on any single number and highlight it and click the single arrow pointing to the right to copy that number to the print box. You may select a group of numbers by holding down the 'alt' key or the 'shift' key and highlighting any number of machine numbers. Clicking the left pointing arrow will copy those numbers to the print box.

By using your mouse and clicking on the right mouse button while the mouse pointer is in the main list box, a popup menu will appear. This menu will allow you to **Find** a number in the main list, **Delete** a number from the main list and **Unselect** all that were selected. When finding a number, the box will scroll to that number's position and it will be highlighted.

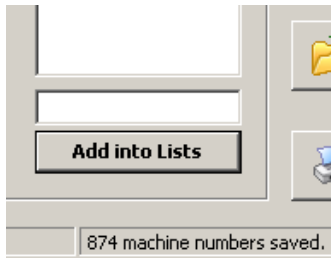


The opposite is true in the print box. If you copy the wrong labels over to the print list, simply select that label or group of labels and click the left pointing single arrow. Those numbers will be removed from the print box.

To copy all of the numbers from one box to another, use the double left or double right pointing arrows.



At the bottom of the print box is a button called "Add into Lists" and above that an edit box. Here you can add labels to be printed AND into the main list. It is assumed that if you are going to add a label to print it should be added into the main list as well.

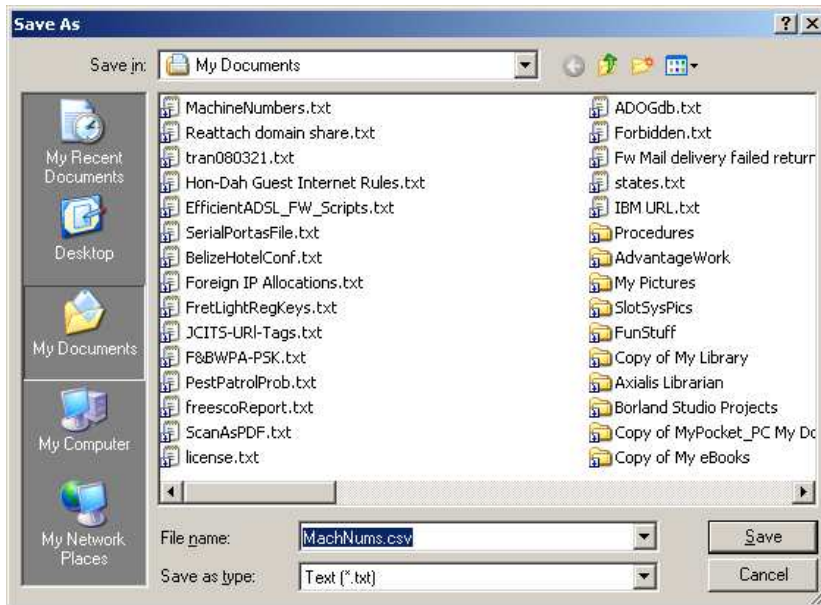


Simply enter your number and click the “Add into Lists” button.

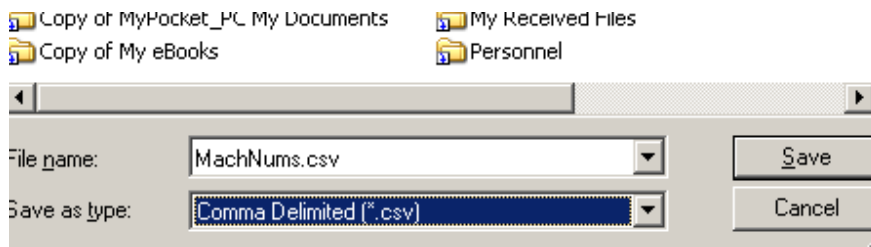
Important: Make certain that if you add or delete labels from the main list, that you save your list. See the following section, Saving Changes.

Saving Changes

If you have deleted items or added items from your main list you need to save them if you want to use them again. You could just print one machine label without opening the main list. If that is the case, do not save the single label. But when preparing multiple labels and changes are made, keep your main list current by clicking the “Save” button.



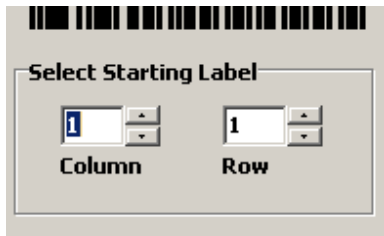
The Save As window appears. You can save the main list as a regular text file (*.txt), vertical or columnar, (see above for a Notepad.exe view) OR you change the format to a comma separated format, (*.csv). (See above for the notepad.exe view of a comma separated file). When done, click “Save”.



To Save As a Comma Delimited file.

Printing Labels

In the upper right portion of the main application window, you will see Select Starting Label.



This allows you to use up partially used sheets of labels. Columns run vertically, up and down, and Rows run horizontally, left to right. Just select the starting label position on your first sheet of labels.

Caution: Sometimes partially used sheets of labels may jam in your printer and can cause a mess. Judgment is needed on your part and if you are willing to use this feature.

Below “Select Starting Label” you can select what type of label(s) you want to print.



You can print just Machine labels, Hot Can labels, Cold Can labels or any combination as shown and allowed.

Once your selections are made, click the “Print” button.

Experiment first on plain paper until you feel comfortable with the operation of this software and your printer.
